Welcome to 2012! During the New Year we are going to introduce some new foods to our snack menu. We will have one new food to try and one food choice that is familiar to the children. We thought this would be a fun way to have our class try some foods and expand their pallets

Did you know that some foods need to be introduced to a child as many as ten to fifteen times before they will try it? Here are some tips on introducing new foods.

- Pick only one or two foods to try.
- Begin with only a small amount such as one pea or one black bean.
- Let your child see you eating the new food and use positive comments about the new food.
- Encourage your child to try the new food without being forceful.
